Safety Instructions	The Contractor shall be responsible for all injury or damage to persons, animals, or things, and for all damage to property or death of any person under a contract of service with the Contractor, which may arise from any factor / omission on the part of the Contractor or any Sub-Contractor or any nominated Sub-Contractor or any of their employees. The liability under the clause shall cover also, inter alia any damage to structures, whether immediately adjacent to the Works or otherwise, any damage to roads, streets, footpaths, bridges as well as damage caused to the building and other structures and Works forming the subject matter of this Contract. The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the ENGINEER and the OWNER and hold them harmless in respect of all and any loss and expenses arising from any such injury or damage to persons or property or death of any person under a contract of service with the contractor as aforesaid and also against any claim made in respect of injury or damage, whether under any statute or otherwise and also in respect of any award of compensation or damage consequent upon such claims. Compliance with Statutes, Regulations, etc. The Contractor shall conform in all respects with the provisions of any such Statute, Ordinance or Law as aforesaid and the regulations or bye-laws of any local or other duly constituted authority which may be applicable to the Works and with such rules and regulations of public bodies and companies as aforesaid and shall keep the OWNER indemnified against all penalties and liabilities of every kind for breach of any such Statute, Ordinance or Law, Regulation or Bye-Laws.
Labour laws & Insurance	You shall comply with all labour laws, Statutory requirements safety rules, payment of taxes, royalty etc. in respect of all material purchased and labor hired by you. The owner shall not be responsible for any lapses in this regard on your part.
Contract Documents Confidential	All documents, correspondence decisions and orders concerning the contract shall be considered as confidential and / or restricted in nature by the contractor and he shall not divulge or allow access to them by any unauthorized person.





Other Instructions	(i) Contractor shall indemnify the Company against any risk and the cost arising out of non-compliance / accident while execution of the contract. Besides contractor shall strictly comply with the instructions issued by the site in charge. Appropriate penalty at company's discretion will be imposed and deducted from contractor's bill for non-compliance of safety provisions on each occasion. (ii) Contractor shall also comply with all statutory provisions like Contract Labour, PF, ESIC, Workmen compensation etc. applicable to his Labor and adhere to the safety norms as per Bureau of Indian Standards SP 70 and rules made there under. Contractor shall strictly comply with the provisions of payment of wages act and extend all other statutory benefits prevailing from time to time to his labor. (iii) The contractor shall instruct his employees to take all necessary safety precautions and ensure that his employees are following such instructions so that no injury or harm is caused to workers. (iv) Contractor is required to engage desired (experienced & trained) manpower to complete the assigned job as per the specifications and within the time frame specified. The assigned job shall be strictly under contractors control and supervision and he may appoint his own competent supervisors for the said purpose. (v) Material challans to be submitted as material received on site with proper gate entry or signature of concerned Engineer & also no empty drums or cartridges of material shall be taken out of the site without prior permission. (vi) Cost towards damage of Somaia's property while execution by your team members will be recovered from contractor's payment.
Responsibilities of Contracting Agency	(i) You will provide a full time Supervisor / Engineer at site to monitor and supervise the work carried out by your sub – contractor or labour and check quality in execution. (ii) Contractor has to submit the daily progress report by 10am every day. The rooms and the existing appliances lying in the room should be kept neat and clean. (iii) Unwanted left over materials/ Debris should be carried out of campus and make the area clean. (iv) Prior permission is to be taken from management to work after office hour/Sundays and Holidays.
Liquidated Damages (LD)	If the Vendor/Contractor fails to supply the Equipment's/complete the Installation work within the time prescribed herein or within extended time for supply of Equipment's/completion of Installation, then, the Vendor/Contractor shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as follows: 01: 0.5% per day maximum up to 10% of Purchase order value. 02: Management will decide whether to apply the Liquidated Damages & execute the order or terminate the order if the progress of supply/Installation is found unsatisfactory as per given delivery schedule.
Warranty	i) The equipment and materials supplied and installed by Supplier shall be Warranted against any defects for a period of 1 year for material from the date of installation and Successful commissioning whichever is later. Warranty will be from OEM. ii) During the warranty period, you shall rectify/replace free of cost all defects in materials and workmanship. iii) You shall give an undertaking for the above warranty at the time of handing over the installation/supply iv) Wherever warranty is provided, the responsibility to replace parts, etc. and keep the item in running condition shall be suppliers responsibility.
Insurance	It shall be suppliers/ contractors responsibility to arrange insurance, for the following:- a) All supplied materials along with materials in transit. b) All workmen associated with the job This shall be provided till the entire installation and commissioning of the equipment/machinery.
Delivery terms	The following document must be accompanied along with Shipment whichever applicable. 1. Delivery challan, 2. Tax Invoice, 3. Test Certificate, 4. LR copy/Courier receipt/Air Way Bill, 5. Warranty certificate, 6. Purchase Order copy/Bill of Landing/packing list/Shipment of Origin/Bill of Entry. Etc.
Delivery Period	i) 10 weeks from the date of receipt of order. ii) Before delivery vendor will inform the Institute and carry out delivery process at respective locations provided by the Institute. iii) Delivery process will be completed same day in working office hours (10.00 am – 4.00 pm).
Terms of Payment	90% advance payment against Bank Guarantee for 90% of the order value and 10% payment after successful deployment of the entire set up. The Bank Guarantee should be valid till successful deployment of the entire set up.

**Termination of
Purchase Order**

If in case the supplier
(a) Becomes bankrupt or insolvent, has a receiving order issued against its creditors, or if the Contractor is a corporation a resolution is passed or order is made for its winding up (Other than a voluntary liquidation for the purposes of amalgamation)
(b) Assigns or transfers the contract or any right or interest therein in violation of the provision of given work to sub-contractor.
(c) In the judgment of the Client, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the order
(d) Has abandoned or repudiated the order
(e) Persistently fails to execute the order in accordance with the supply without just cause or refuses or is unable to provide sufficient materials services or labor to execute and complete the works in the manner specified in the program furnished.
Then Client may, without prejudice to any other rights it may possess under the Supply Agreement, give a notice to the supplier stating the nature of the default and requiring the supplier to remedy the same. If the supplier fails to remedy the same within seven (7) days of its receipt of such notice then Client may terminate the order forthwith by giving a notice of termination to the supplier.
In case, supplier fails to carry out the work as specified in the schedule or left in between, it will be got done through any other agency at suppliers' risk and cost, the same shall be removed from the amount payable to the supplier plus 20% towards supervision charges of the same.
